- Q.4 Read the following passage carefully and answers the questions given at the end. (25)**
- The Punjab University Library had a very modest beginning with the acquisition of about 2,000 volumes in 1873 at a cost of Rs. 2500. These volumes belonged to Sir Donald Frieled Mcleod, Lieutenant Governor of the Punjab (1865-70) and were purchased for the Punjab University College, which developed into a university under the Punjab University Act of 1882. One of the oldest library in Pakistan, not much attention seems to have been paid to the management and augmentation of this collection till 1903 when Mr. (later Dr.) A.C. Woolner, Registrar and Principal of the Oriental College, Lahore, was appointed honorary librarian. The present building situated at 1-Alberuni Road, Lahore, was designed by Bhai Ram Singh, Principal, Mayo School (now National College) of Arts, Lahore, and was built on a site acquired in 1910 in proximity to the Senate Hall. Its foundation-stone was laid by the Chancellor, Sir Louis Dane, on February 27, 1911, and the two-storey structure was completed in February, 1917, at a cost of Rs. 1,60,000. A noticeable feature of the library, now having about 3,00,000 books (including more than 18,000 manuscripts), is that about one-fifth of its holdings consist of private collections of published books and/or manuscripts received by way of donations or purchased from the owners or their heirs. The Library contains a rich research collection of printed books, especially on the humanities and social sciences. It is particularly rich in old and rare editions.
